Indigo Dyeing Workshop

In this three hour workshop, the beautiful variations of blue available with Indigo dye will be explored using various tie dye methods to pattern the fabric. Students are welcome to bring their own projects, but only natural fibres such as cotton or silk are feasible. (Silk scarves ready for dyeing will be available for purchase if required).

MATERIALS:

Students to bring:

One metre cotton to be cut into sample sized pieces, plus assorted other pieces of natural fibre fabrics in light colours.

Needle and thread

Old clothing or apron.

Rubber Gloves

Closed-in footwear.

2-3metres light coloured natural fibre fabric, such as cotton, linen or silk. (optional)

Pre-washed Tshirts or clothing in natural fabric (optional)

Please note: Some fabrics such as calico have stiffening in them that will resist dye, so they need rigorous washing first.
