# Shoemaking beginners and continuers

Participants will learn or continue to enhance their shoemaking skills in this 35 hour workshop using the **traditional method of lasting**. Students will make a pattern, evaluate, cut leather, sew components and 'last' the shoe. Heels are made individually for each design using specific heel leather / resin.

The class has a maximum of 6 students.
