On completion of this class, students will understand the basic techniques of making pots, using a potter's wheel and have made a series of small bowls which will have been decorated with a glaze finish.

COURSE PROGRAMME:

The course aims to bring the student to a level where they are able to:

- Learn basic throwing and forming techniques to make shapes such as bowls and cylinders
- Turn and finish the pots.
- Understand the firing and glazing process.
- Continuing students will better improve their skill, work on new projects and experiment with new techniques

STUDENTS TO BRING:

- 4 or 5 large Kitchen Tidy plastic bags. (with no holes)
- Apron and towel
- Territory Craft supply some tools. A basic pottery tool kit is available from Jackson's in Parap. It is not essential but very useful.

Students are to attend class wearing closed in shoes and appropriate clothing at all times.
