

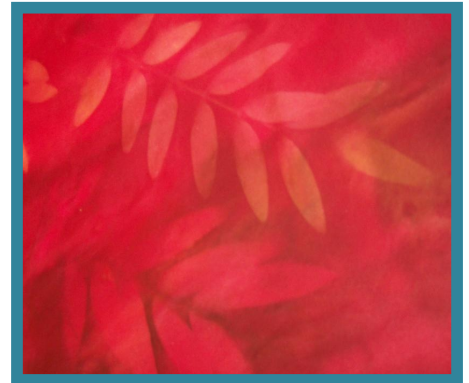
Sunprinting Fabric with Paint

Course Outcome

Sunprinting is an exciting and fun technique that uses the sun to create patterns. Sunblocks will be created using found objects such as leaves, buttons, bits of plastic and metal, rice, paper cut design. The final design is created by overlaying paint on fabric with a visit to the sun.

Participants to bring:

Found objects such as above and bits of foam (ex around new appliances), odd nuts & bolts, slotted spoons or anything with a pattern. Jillian will provide some but you may wish to bring your own to create an individual design.

2 Metre of natural fabric, cotton or silk, or a couple of pre washed cotton T-shirts

STUDENTS ARE TO ATTEND CLASS WEARING CLOSED IN SHOES, AN APRON OR COVERALL AND GLOVES WHEN WORKING WITH THE PAINTS.
