Each workshop will require a backing board to rest your work on, plastic eraser, kneadable eraser, sharpener, scalpel blade.

For the following weeks you will need these specific materials as well:

Weeks 1 & 2 Graphite - a range of graphite pencils HB, 2B, 4B, 6B and smooth drawing paper)

Weeks 3 & 4 Pen and ink – a range of Artline Drawing System Pens nib sizes (0.1, 0.3, 0.5) and smooth drawing paper and drafting film

Weeks 5 & 6 Coloured Pencil - a range of coloured pencils preferably Faber Castell Polychromos or Derwent "Artists quality" pencils, smooth drawing paper and drafting film.

Course outline:

This workshop looks at the steps to drawing birds using three different drawing mediums graphite, pen and ink and coloured pencil. Participants will produce a series on bird drawings using each medium on art paper and drafting film. The course will cover in detail how to draw birds, their eggs, feathers and nests. Specimens of birds, eggs, feathers and nests will be provided by the instructor.
