Bring out those well-loved clothes and give them a new lease on life! Is there a slight blemish on their reputation? A red wine splash or the sauce that made the difference to an otherwise pristine garment. The gap from mouth to plate can entirely change a once loved garment. Now is the chance to turn that blemish into a creative adventure, a thing of the past and a brand new garment will appear! If your piece is a natural fibre bring it along and revamp it or just make something new! Plan for that fantastic Xmas Gift this Christmas. This course will consist of six modules of 3 hours.

## STUDENTS TO BRING

Fabric (Natural fibres: cotton, linen, silk or rayon) at least 1 metre. All fabric to be well washed, Calico is excellent. In addition 6 x A4 size sample pieces to experiment with as well. Foam Roller (Spotlight). Each week you will be given your next weeks fabric needs.

Week 1: Basic Fabric Printing. Colour Theory, Scrunch Spraying Fabric for background pattern, Tape resist (using a foam roller to apply paint over the tape to create a "resist" pattern)

Week 2: Printing with found objects. Produce a 1 x 1 metre tablecloth. Produce a pattern using objects without needing to draw! Pattern design will be discussed and use of colours to create a theme. Heat setting paint to make it washable will also be covered.

Week 3: Stencil Printing. Learn to design and cut out a stencil and print it using a roller. Extending what was taught in week 2.

Week 4: Block Printing. Learn how to design and cut out a lino block for printing. Enhance fabric with this method and heat set it.

Week 5 and 6: Basic Tie Dyeing using folding and wrapping techniques. Suitable for dyeing well loved clothing in need of a revamp or to dye up some fabric to print later or just to have some fun with.
